The Campbellsville-Taylor County Chamber of Commerce will be issuing one \$750 cash scholarship in May of 2026 to one High School Senior.

The Chamber of Commerce recognizes the need for cash flow and we, as a Chamber, want to provide the cash students need for incidentals and unexpected expenses that will help with a smooth transition to college life.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

1. A senior whose primary residence is in Taylor County and who will graduate in the spring of 2026.
2. Will attend full-time or part-time at an accredited college/university, junior college or trade school in the fall of 2026.
3. Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0. (Copy of **transcript required**)
4. Submit a personal essay (see below for content) not to exceed three pages, double-spaced and typed.
5. Two letters of recommendation from community members. The letters should address the applicant's community involvement.
6. Delivery of the completed application, essay and letters of recommendation to the office listed above by April 24, 2026.

#### **Procedures**

Completed applications that meet the above criteria and are received or postmarked by the April 24, 2026 deadline will be reviewed by the scholarship committee of the Campbellsville-Taylor County Chamber of Commerce. Those students not selected will be notified shortly thereafter. *(Use as many additional pages as needed to complete the application)*
